7. ROAD NAMING AT PACKINGTON HALL DEVELOPMENT

Members are requested to consider the naming of one road [site location: Land at Packington Hall]. The developer has suggested the following names with reasoning [the suffixes may need to be changed to fit the type of road]:

James Wyatt Way - The architect of Packington Hall was James Wyatt the build was commissioned by Zachary Babington

Lady Walk - The wood visible from the boundary of Packington hall is called the Lady walk and it was the route that the Levett family took when they walked to Hopwas to church. Mary Babington married Theophilus Levett family. The Levett family lived in the hall for 200 years

Babington Folly - The first owner of Packington Hall. Zachary Babington was the high sheriff of Staffordshire when he commissioned Packington Hall to be built. The now demolished house in Hopwas wood was called Babington's Folly.

Hopwas Mews - The bridal path running alongside the wood on the boundary to Packington Hall is called Hopwas Hayes bridal way. It used to be the main road to Tamworth 200 years ago well before the A51 was ever built.

Levett Road, Botany Bay

The Chairman made reference to Minute No. 59 [Chairman's Announcements - Levett Road, Botany Bay] and explained that two/three developers had shown an interest in the land [owned by Mr J Barnes]. It was agreed by Members that the developer should make a payment towards the main sewer [actually overloaded on this site and would need an update]. Members agreed that a one-way traffic system would be of benefit and the site would need appropriate screening.
